Applicant Eligibility:

1. The Ada Lions Memorial Academic and Service Awards are for \$500 to \$1,000 and is a one-time only award. The applicants must be enrolled full-time at Ada High School and intend to enroll in a postsecondary institution after high school graduation.
2. Recipients must be a graduate from Ada High School with a Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. The cumulative GPA is calculated at the end of the first semester of the applicant's senior year.
3. Applicant must be recommended for the Ada Lions Memorial Academic and Service Award by the following: principal, guidance counselor or a faculty member of Ada Exempted Village School District.
4. Financial need is considered by the Ada Lions.
5. Applications must be submitted by April 1. Those applications submitted after this deadline will not be considered.

Applicant Instructions:

1. Complete the entire application form.
2. Request that your Guidance Counselor attach a copy of your transcript to the application.
3. Provide two references (list personal attributes) with the completed application. A letter from each reference must accompany this application.
4. Request a statement from principal, guidance counselor, or faculty member recommending you for this Award. (See application)
5. Return the completed application to the Ada High School Guidance Office by April 1.
6. Upon enrollment at a postsecondary institution, the Recipient must send the Bursar's Statement to the Ada Lions Club to receive the Award.

Note: The Ada Lions Memorial Academic and Service Award will be presented at the Ada Awards Day at Ada High School and at an Ada Lions Club Meeting. It will be awarded when the Ada Lions Club receives the Bursar's Billing Statement.
