Applicant Eligibility:

1. The Ada Lions Memorial Academic and Service Awards are for \$500 to \$1,000 and is a one-time only award. The applicants must be enrolled full-time at Ada High School and intend to enroll in a post secondary institution after high school graduation.
2. Recipients must be a graduate from Ada High School with a Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. The cumulative GPA is calculated at the end of the first semester of the applicant's senior year.
3. Applicant must be recommended for the Ada Lions Memorial Academic and Service Award by the following: principal, guidance counselor or a faculty member of Ada Exempted Village School District.
4. **Financial need is considered by the Ada Lions Club. Please be very specific in describing your need for this award.**
5. **Applications must be submitted by March 15 and must be TYPED. The only accepted applications for consideration are available on the Ada Guidance Department web site or the Ada Lions Club web site. A transcript should be attached to the application.**

Applicant Instructions:

1. Complete the entire application form **by typing it** from the application that is on line at the Ada Guidance or Ada Lions Scholarship web site.
3. Provide two references (list personal attributes) with the completed application. A letter from each reference must accompany this application.
4. Request a statement from principal, guidance counselor, or faculty member recommending you for his Award. (See application)
5. Return the completed application to the Ada High School Guidance Office **by March 15. (If the 15th falls on a weekend the application deadline will Monday by 4:00 p.m.)**
6. Upon enrollment the Recipient must send the Lions Scholarship Chair a copy of Bursar's Billing Statement proving they are enrolled in college to receive the award.

Note: The Ada Lions' Memorial Academic and Service Award will be presented at the Ada Awards Day at Ada High School and at an Ada Lions' Club Meeting. **Attendance at the Ada Lions' Club Meeting Dinner is strongly recommended.** All successful award winners will receive a personal invitation to the Ada Lions Club Dinner. **Critical information on obtaining the award will be handed out at the Ada Lions Club Dinner.**
